You can elect to receive invoices daily or one summarized invoice of all individual deliveries over a specified period of time (weekly or monthly) in any format required.

Customer Part Numbers

Summit can load your internal part numbers as a cross reference to Summit's part number. All sales documents can include your part number, along with manufacturer part number and extended description. This helps in receiving and reconciling invoices.

Custom Order Fields

You can request custom fields to be required and captured for each sales order, such as employee number, badge number, or additional purchase information text.

Bar Coding

Summit can print bar-coded item labels for all customer part numbers. We can utilize bar-code technology for all aspects of the material management process, including warehouse shelving, trailer shelving, all appropriate catalogs, and material data sheets. Your copy of delivery receipts, packing labels, summary billings, and any other required documentation can also be bar coded with your

criteria. Summit has a web-based inventory management tool to assist with inventory replenishment.

Kitting/Staging

Summit has the ability to kit and stage material as required. SAP allows us to assign a part number to a group of material, giving managers the ability to view and order, by detail or kit, the complete bill of material for assembly. All kitted and staged items will be clearly tagged and marked with all pertinent information.

Material Take-Off (MTO) Services

Summit utilizes the services of electrical designers and engineers to perform material take-off services. We can perform take-offs by drawing, detail, and unit or area. Drawings will need to be in AutoCad format. Please allow one to two hours per drawing after download to complete take-off. Summit will guarantee a 99% accuracy rate utilizing our services.

AMPS® Process

The AMPS® process encompasses six basic steps, each one deliberately simple.



1. Process Action Team

A process action team is established to work with your project managers, attend regular meetings, and coordinate procurement and delivery activities. The purpose of the team is to proactively manage any scheduling or supply changes.



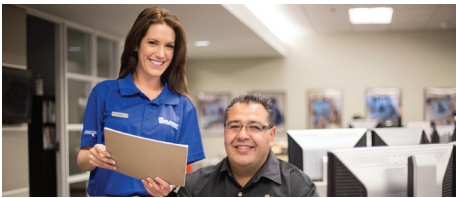
2. Establish Materials List

Summit works with your project managers and engineers to determine an accurate list of materials required for each stage of the project. The materials list forms the basis of the project's electronic catalog, providing for long-lead-time items and minimizing non-stock items. Our central replenishment department ensures required inventory is available and establishes minimum/maximum levels for each item. This initial setup helps establish the most cost-effective inventory plan at the outset of the project.



3. Set Up Storage Location

A storage location is then set up. This may be an onsite manned (or unmanned) job trailer, a separate Summit warehouse, or warehouse space within the customer's facility that is managed by Summit. Setup includes providing all necessary equipment such as forklifts and computers, as well as inventory.



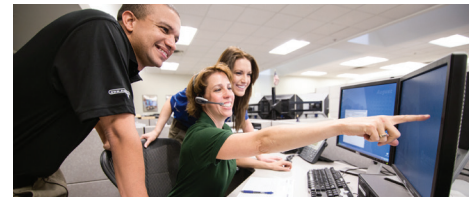
4. Set Up in SAP

The storage location is set up in SAP as a Summit-managed "ship-to" location with its own individual inventory requirements, income and expense records, and transaction records. This results in more accurate ordering and delivering, as well as more specific reporting capabilities.



5. Staging and Release of Materials

Through SAP, materials staging and release is a smooth and simple process. Approved employees can submit orders at the storage location and receive what they need immediately. Managers can also order materials through the electronic project catalog and have them delivered to the job site as needed.



6. Transaction Tracking and Reporting

The process includes continuous transaction tracking and reporting. Summit can provide customized usage reports on a predetermined schedule, or can allow the customer to generate on-demand reports. Project status and tracking is also available through the online AMPS Portal.

Summit provides comprehensive solutions for all of your onsite needs. Summit OnSite® – or SOS® – offers customizable mobile storage for your job site, the ability to set up Summit-manned or customer-manned facilities, and complete onsite inventory management.

Summit uses mobile, ground-level storage containers to meet even your toughest remote onsite needs. They provide the durability and security you expect, while offering the versatility that you require for each job site.

Containers can be configured to your specifications by the available space at each job site, and can be joined together using roll-up doors and docking connections. Their ground-level positioning also offers much faster and more efficient loading and restocking, plus greater safety for job-site crew.

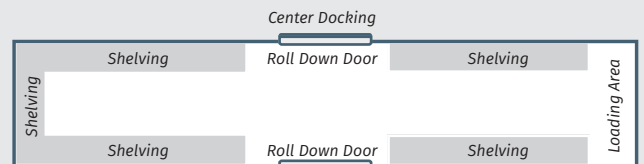
You can choose warehouse units or counter sales units for each job site, or mix and match to create a custom configuration that meets your requirements. Every unit is prewired and includes modular electrical and installed communications. Counter sales units also include HVAC and inventory units have exhaust fans.

Before your SOS facilities ship, they are preconfigured with mounted shelving and can even be preloaded with product, so they arrive on your job site ready to do business. Containers measure 8' x 9'6" x 40'.

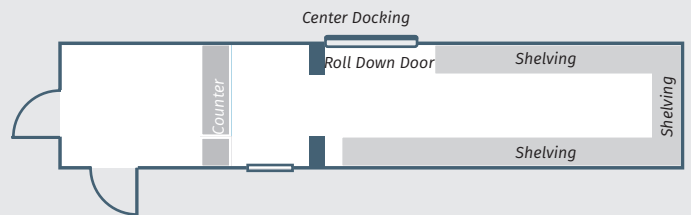
Summit can also provide onsite and inventory management services from job-site trailers, cages, cribs, or other warehouse structures, including customer-provided facilities.

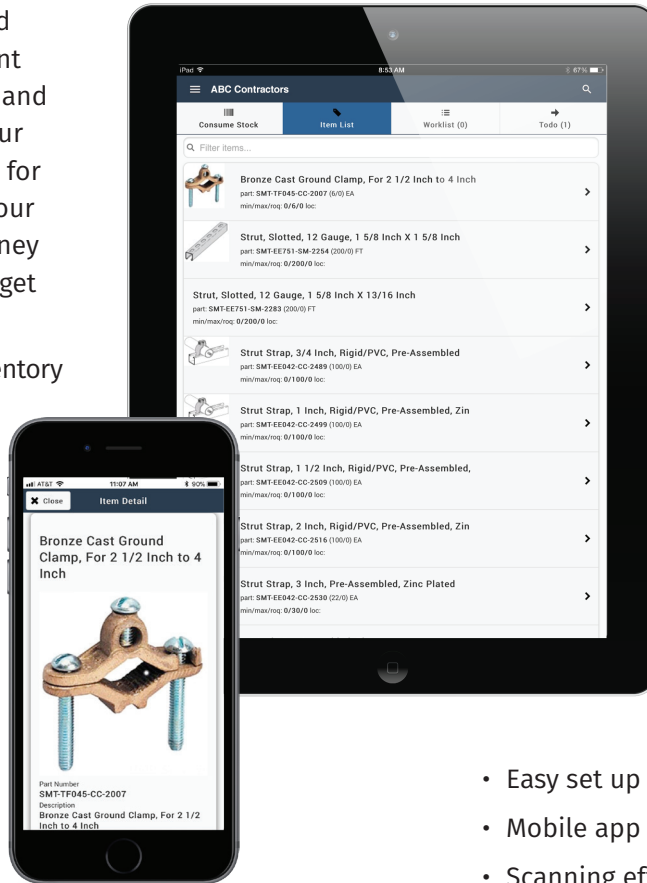
Summit's inventory tool can be used on any Android or iOS device, making it perfect for use in the field at mobile units, trailers, cribs, and more. A convenient

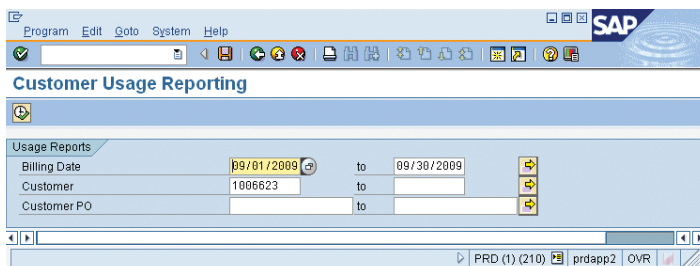

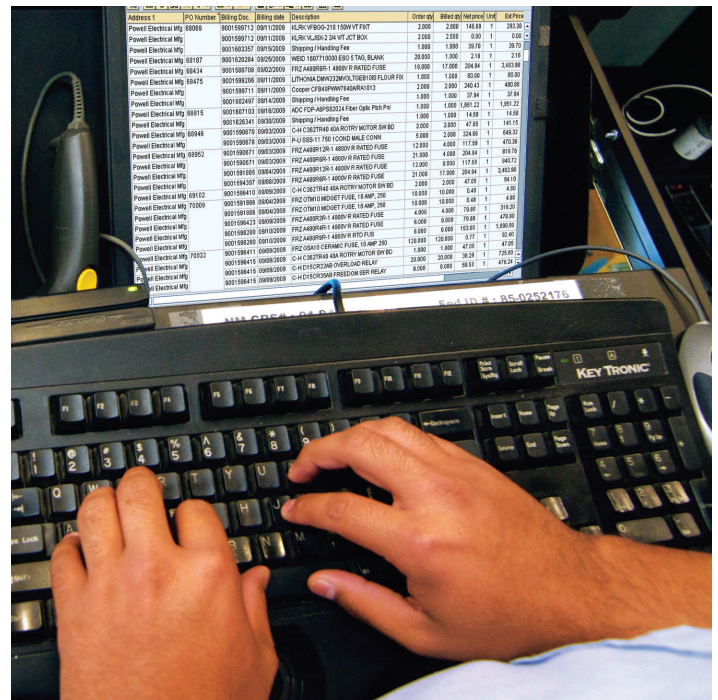

With AMPS®, Summit forecasts inventory requirements by specific location. Each storage location, whether a trailer, cage, or other warehouse space, is set up as a Summit “distribution center” with full SAP functionality. Materials are loaded into a designated SAP account that allows for complete visibility of real-time, on-hand quantities and deliveries.

Customers gain distinctive supply and service advantages by Summit’s ability to replenish the storage locations proactively based on the demands generated on site. The demands are analyzed by Summit’s Material Requirement Planning (MRP) system, which updates every four hours.



By setting up the storage location as a separate “ship-to” location, reorder points and forecasting parameters can be set so that location’s needs are seen separately from any other. The system also analyzes the number of turns per item and shows slow moving or dead stock.



In essence, our inventory management solution allows for real-time monitoring of stock requirements for each managed warehouse space at the individual material level.

The system provides customers with optimal transparency and control over materials.

Wire and Cable Management



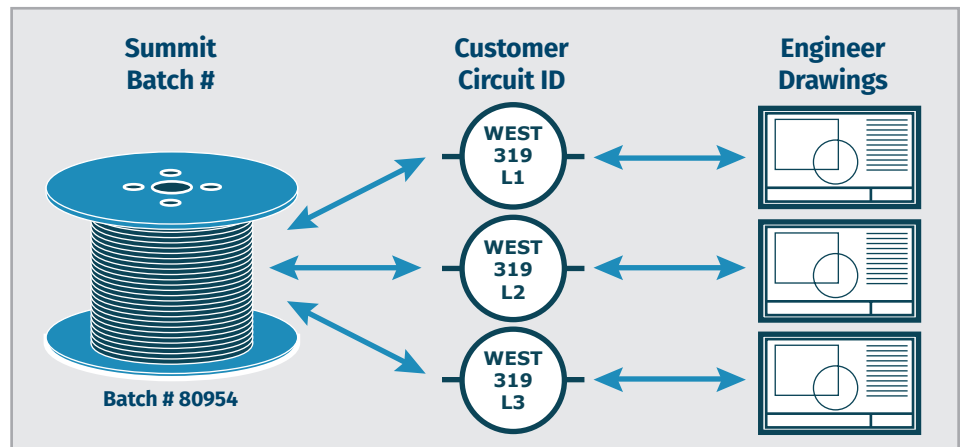
Wire and cable management is an important part of any construction project. SAP allows us to track the length of materials on each reel or batch. When an order is entered, the system designates which reel or batch is most efficient to use in filling the order.

As a result, Summit scraps less than one half of 1 percent of our own wire and cable. We can do the same for you.

SAP's robust functionality also allows Summit to track individual circuits down to the specific project installation. After entering circuit ID numbers and descriptions into our system, Summit can match your circuits to our own batch numbers. This gives you detailed order information not just at the material level, but also to related engineer drawings indicating the material's precise implementation.

A Cost-Effective Approach

- Our approach to cable management begins by buying all cable up front, based on your cable schedule. We keep critical runs in stock to eliminate lead-time issues.
- Though cable is purchased in advance of need, you are invoiced only after receiving it for use.
- We do not use a third party for cable management.

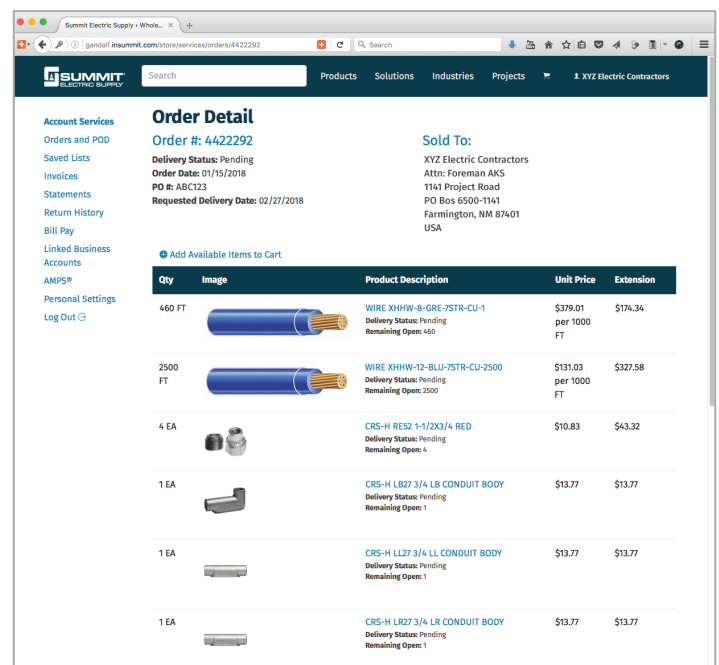
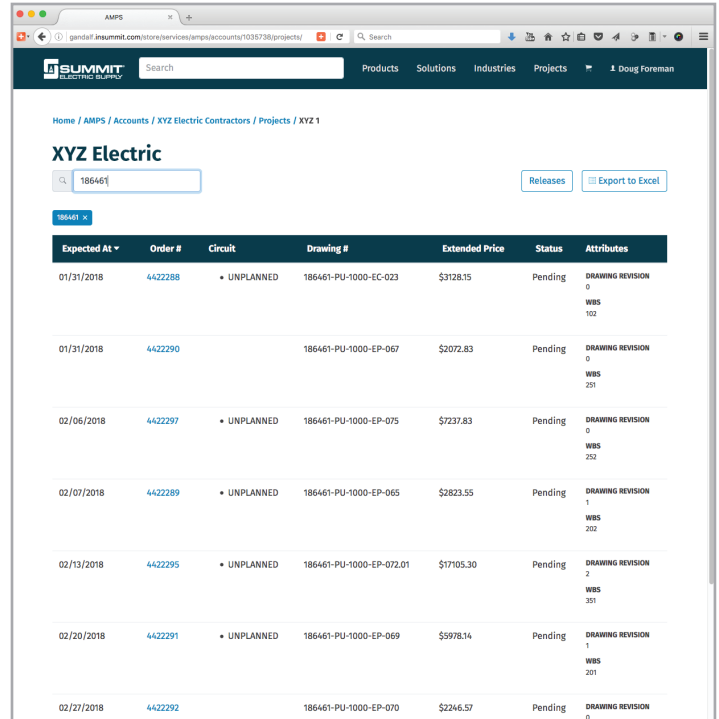
The **project screen** displays a list of orders derived from individual drawing numbers.

Static information will appear on every order, every time, including date, order number, drawing number, price, etc. There are up to nine customizable attributes that you can determine. Each static and attribute heading can be sorted simply by clicking on a heading. You may have multiple project screens.

A **drop-down filter** narrows order selections by column headings. Once a heading is selected, you can narrow even further by entering specific filter terms that apply to that heading.

The **order detail screen** displays a material-level view of every item on an order, according to its drawing number.

View detailed delivery information for every order, including delivery date, who received the order, work package number, PO number, etc. Delivery documents are also available. You can choose up to six custom attributes for tracking delivery information.

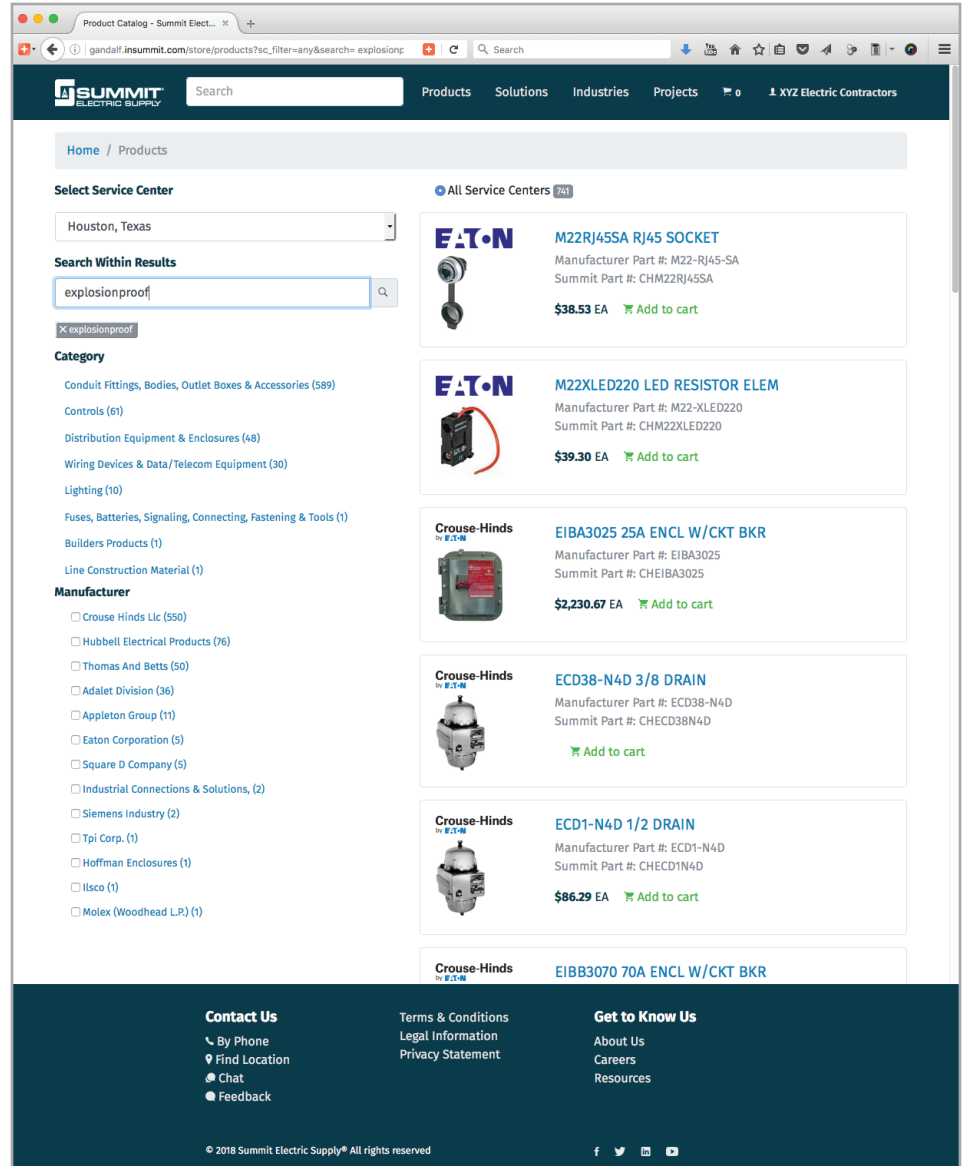

The system helps reduce paperwork and increases efficiency by tracking all transactions online. You can access all orders, invoices, statements and credit memos related to their accounts by date range, purchase order or status. Invoices and statements can be downloaded as PDFs.

Proof of Delivery

Online orders and invoices include proof of delivery/tracking information. If delivered by a Summit truck, invoices also include a scanned image of the signature block from the delivery document.



Material Take-Off (MTO) Services



Summit utilizes the services of electrical designers and engineers to perform material take-offs by drawing, detail, and unit or area.

When performing a complete take-off, Summit will generate the material list and guarantee materials and quantities against the drawing. We'll also compare our material lists to yours, then enter all materials into SAP. Once ordered, we'll stage materials for delivery as required.

For detailed drawings, Summit will perform the material take-off and enter materials directly into SAP. Summit's part number for the complete material list will match the detail drawing number.

You can view all materials included in the detail from Summit's online site. Just select the part number to display a drop-down menu of all materials.

Each packing slip will also include a complete list of material with each drawing to assist with checking-in material and verifying required items have been included in the delivery.

Summit's summary billing will only show the drawing number as the part number.
